BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES OFFERED

MAHIA PENINSULA – Tuesday 30 March



The Mahia Peninsula projects south into the sea between Poverty Bay and Hawkes Bay. The scenery out there is magnificent, and on a clear day you can see for miles with some great photography being undertaken in this area. You will find a beach around the edges of Mahia Peninsula, sandy coves, rocky bays and expanses of surf coast. Mahia is also a peaceful holiday village and a natural playground.

We will drive out to Mahia via a back road (not tar sealed) which will take us about 2-2¼ hours. The day will be spent on the peninsula travelling through Pongaroa Station, owned by Sir Michael Fay and driving around the coastline. You may also drive to a landmark where you can view from a distance Rocket Lab and Portman Island. Other aspects of interest are still being worked on but I can assure you this will be a full day. Your newsletters will keep you updated.

Once the planned activities are completed you will be free to amble around Mahia at your own leisure and return to Gisborne when you wish to. On your way back consider booking into the Morere Hot Springs (State Highway 2) for a swim. Bookings essential though.

WHAKARAU ROAD to MOTU – Wednesday 31 March - COMPETITIVE RUN



Upon leaving the Events Centre you will drive along State Highway 2 turning right off the highway onto the Whakarau Road (approx. 1hr). This is not a tar sealed road but a good country road of big hills and a good dose of wit which will take you through to Motu. There may also be a couple of fords to entertain you. Once this was the only 'road' between Gisborne and Opotiki. The road carried on through Motu, across the River by the Motu Falls and through what is Whinray Reserve.

The countryside is amazing but we ask you to consider the farmers and any stock that may be wandering or being moved. This is the Competitive Run so there will be questions to be answered.

When you arrive at the Motu you will be free to explore the area at your own leisure. There is a car park at the Whinray Scenic Reserve, toilets and picnic tables. Follow the walking path (approx. 5 min) which leads to the swing bridge. From here you will have the best view of the Motu Falls. Once you arrive at the Motu you will be able to spend your time taking a look around the area, or enjoying a cup of tea at the old Motivation Café whilst taking in the history of the area.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES OFFERED

GRAND RALLY, TINIROTO – Thursday 01 April



The small village of Tiniroto is about a 1-hour drive southwest of Gisborne. Surrounded by the Ruakituri and Hangaroa Rivers with the mighty maunga Mt Whakapunake in the background. Tiniroto is a scenic and tranquil environment. Visitors can enjoy exploring Doneraille Park with the native bush beside the river, trout fishing, swimming and camping. The Tiniroto Tavern is a great local pub in the heart of rural Gisborne with great kiwi hospitality. The only pub I have been to where I have brought an ice-cream.

You will drive approx. 61km along State Highway 38 and turn off to Doneraille Park onto the Ruakaka Road. This road is not tar-sealed and to begin with the road is windy and steep until you reach the bridge (see picture). Once you have crossed the bridge you will enter Doneraille Park. Stop and have a look around then continue to your destination driving along the road to 'Kaikino Station'.

A grand day will be planned beside the air strip at Kaikino along with a buffet meal, refreshments and entertainment.

MV TAKITIMU - Saturday 03 April



Experience a relaxing morning cruise on NZ's oldest pilot vessel. Departing from the inner Gisborne harbour, the trip takes approx 1.25 hours. There are breathtaking views of the stunning Poverty Bay with the boat cruising right up to Young Nicks Head. This boat is notable for the amount of original fixtures and fittings that have survived.

The boat takes 20 persons with lifejackets supplied.

If there is enough interest in this wonderful cruise the Captain has offered an extra sailing. First in first served.

WA165 STEAM TRAIN RIDE



MURIWAI ' A two-hour journey which departs Gisborne at the Train Station and heads south over the Gisborne Airport and into the fertile Poverty Bay countryside. Wa165 steams along and over xxx bridge before stopping at Muriwai for a photo opportunity and cup of tea. This wonderful steam train has a lot of history, being built originally in Dunedin. In 1985 a group of rail enthusiasts got together and formed the Gisborne City Vintage Railway Society with the sole purpose of rebuilding this locomotive.

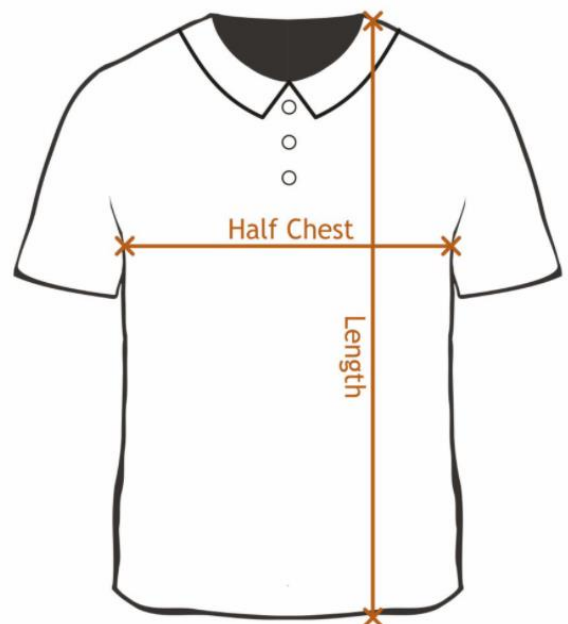


HOW TO MEASURE
