# **Matamata Car Run**

## **12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> February 2021**

*Please note that before we start on Saturday morning there is a 'flea' market held in front of the Matamata Primary School on Broadway. It has a bit of everything available from baking, to fruit and vegetables, toys, plants tools, and what have you! That starts at 7am and runs until about 12.00 noon (takes more than 5 minutes this one). Public toilets are on Hetana Street in town.*

Those Model A's that arrive in Matamata Friday evening we could arrange venue for a get together.

### **The main run is on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February**

- To start the day on Saturday please assemble at a collection point at 9.45 am to travel 2mins to Swaps shed in the industrial park.
- Our 2nd visit is to the Diprose property about 5mins out of town to see a tractor collection and we are scheduled to arrive at 11.30.
- Lunch 12.30pm and there is plenty of choice in town or you can have a picnic at Stewart and Raewyn's home where there is plenty of parking and shade, tea, etc., available ... bring a rug.
- Our next visit is a 20min drive to the Wapiti deer park. (A tour where Ian will tell us about velvet production and trophy head breeding). The total tour cost is \$100 divided up per car.
- A buffet style dinner at the Matamata Club is available for \$30.00 per head. This includes two meats, etc. Minimum numbers are required (20) – **so please let us know by 28<sup>th</sup> January 2021.** For 50 people plus they would set up a separate room for us.

On **Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> February** we visit to a muscle car garage. Plus in Cambridge, a large collection of cars and other displays with the adjoining building full of mainly earthmoving gear the centre piece a massive Komatsu dozer ex Stockton Mine. It is one of six built! See if anyone will climb the ladder to get into this beast (minimum number of people required is 20). We believe this display is only open during the week, but they will open for groups by arrangement. It is well recommended for young and old at \$5.00 per head (minimum 20 required).
