# Third Newsletter for the 17<sup>th</sup> National Model A Ford Rally, Masterton/ Wairarapa. 23-28<sup>th</sup> February, 2025

#### June 2024

We now have 100 cars pre-registered as 'Early-bird' registrants.

If you have not booked accommodation in the Masterton area there is booking information on the NIMAFC website, just look for the 'box' labelled 17<sup>th</sup> National Rally that will take you to lots of information. <a href="www.modelafordclub.co.nz">www.modelafordclub.co.nz</a>. The Solway Copthorne Hotel has only seven rooms left at this stage. There is a list of Motels below to assist you with bookings if you are unable to get a room at the Copthorne Solway Hotel.

The program is close to being finalized. There have been a few subtle changes since the last newsletter.

#### **Sunday 23-2-2025**

**Registration/Check-in desk** will be open from 1200 -1900 hours in the Copthorne Solway Hotel, 246 High Street, Masterton 5810. (It will also be open from 0700 to 0900 and 1600 to 1800 each day)

**1700** hours 'Noggin 'n' Natter', self-pay drinks at the Solway Hotel Bar. Catch up with your 'old' friends and make some new ones!

**1800** hours (onwards) you have a choice of dining at the Solway Hotel Restaurant or going to a local restaurant in Masterton with a group of friends. A list of restaurants will be in your Rally Booklet.

At Check-in, guests will be allocated to four groups, colour-coded Red, Yellow, Green and Blue. There will be one quarter of you in each group. You can elect to be in a particular group with your friends. Each day for Tuesday to Friday there will be four different 'runs' in progress to four different destinations. There are two 'long runs' and two 'short runs'. If you do a long run one day, you will be doing a short run the next day. By the end of the week everyone will have been to each of the four destinations (unless your car breaks down!).

Please read your Rally Booklet on Sunday night to see what is happening on Monday! (and the rest of the week)

Route instructions for each of the four 'runs' will be printed in your Rally Booklet, so you will need to bring it with you each day, Tuesday-Friday.

#### **Saturday 21-3-2025**

We have three interesting Guest Speakers who shall remain secret until you get your Rally Booklets on Sunday 23-2-2025.

Before the Rally make sure your car's Insurance, Registration and WOF and servicing are up-to-date.

Due to the hot summers in the Wairarapa there will be a high fire risk in the countryside so you must bring a fire extinguisher. A tow rope, jumper cables and a suitable set of tools and simple spare parts (like a fan belt and ignition points) are recommended. It is unlikely that chains will be needed. You should make sure your car's fuel tank (38 litres/10 US gallons) is full by the start of each day's travelling. Please bring two carpet squares to put under your car at night to absorb the inevitable oil drips that most Model As have. (Be tidy Kiwis, keep the hotel/motel carparks clean!)

We will have a flat-bed trailer for recovery on the Castlepoint 'run'. Fagan Ford Dealership will have a flatbed trailer towed by a Ford Ranger for recoveries for the other 'runs' on a 'call if required' basis. You could also activate an AA call-out if you have AA membership.

We also suggest you bring a light-weight chair each and a 'Thermos' and supply your own tea/coffee/biscuits/sandwiches for morning and afternoon tea/coffee stops. It will say on the route notes each day if you can buy a.m. and p.m. tea/coffee or have to bring your own.

We have not yet been able to finalize the Registration Costs. We are still working on Apparel for the Rally. Rally logo badges in metal/enamel form have been ordered. Full information about costs and clothing will be in the next (and final) newsletter at the end of July.

The formal Registration Document will be available at the end of August. Registrations will close at the end of November, to give us plenty of time for printing etc to be done before the 'Christmas/January holiday 'shut-down' that NZ experiences each year!

An 'Ad' about the 17<sup>th</sup> Rally will appear in the VCC 'Beaded Wheels' magazine until the end of this year.

We are looking for innovative suggestions for the driving skills/Grass Gymkhana, so please send us your ideas to help make the Gymkhana a fun event.
