| 1. | Le Gra Vineyard, Opaki. | 3 x Cheeses, Le Gra Chutneys, bread and butter pickles, pinot gris pickled pumpkin, fresh fruit, pates, smoked salmon, cracker and breads, served on platters. |
| 2. | Cobblestones Museum, Greytown. | Sausage rolls, quiches, bacon & egg pie, Club sandwiches, Sliders with ham or chicken Fruit & Sweet treat platters Unlimited tea or coffee |
| 3. | Whakataki Hotel, Castlepoint. | Buffet style lunch with 2x cold meats with condiments to match. Salads with lettuce, tomatoes, etc to then build a bun or sandwich, or people can make a plate of their choice. A sweet 'slice' for dessert. |
| 4. | Luna Estate Vineyard, Martinborough. | Two Choices. 1. Chicken Katsu curry 2. Pumpkin Katsu curry (this is 'gluten free' & 'dairy free') |
| | Which meal you get on which day will depend on which colour group you are in and which route you are driving. | |
